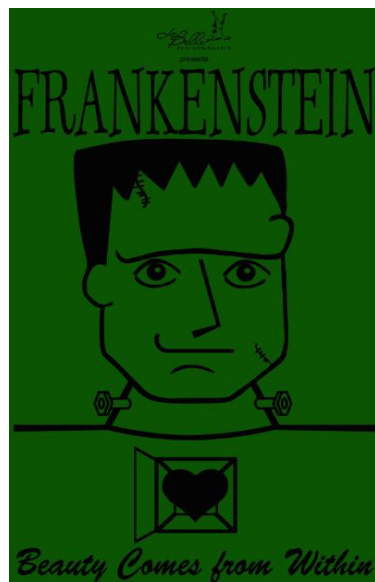
Congratulations Mrs. Brandi
