Costume Week (Nov. 16-22)

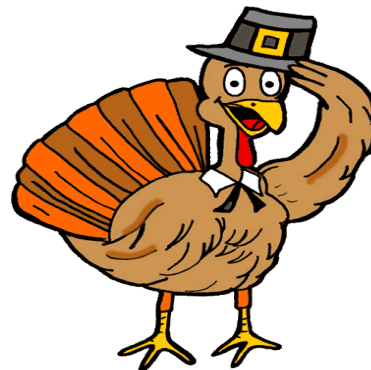

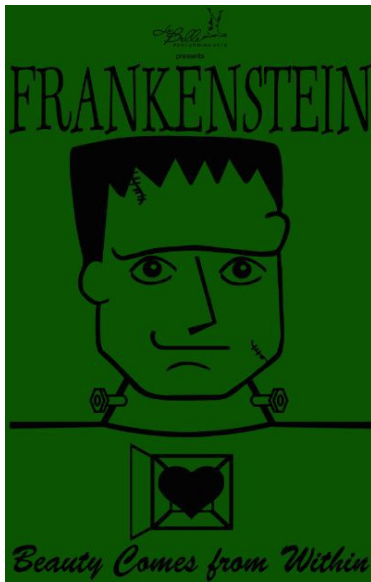
