For Elementary and Middle his program will run Monday-Thursday in the classroom and Fridays at home and occasionally through Zoom. The students will be given instructions on Thursday for Friday's assignments.

After all academic instruction is complete for the day, students will then transition to their performing arts schedule where they will train for the remainder of their day. Our teachers will be there to assist in this transition and make sure every student is where they need to be.

Classes:

- Core classes: Ballet, Jazz, Tap, Contemporary, Hip Hop, Lyrical, and Ballroom.
